## **Bee Class and Monkey Class Trip to The Margate Art Gallery Turner Contemporary**

The Margate Art Gallery Turner Contemporary is working with Herne Bay Infant School to deliver a programme of activities based on the galleries upcoming exhibition of Roman 'Puoding Pan' pots, which were uncovered off the coast of Herne Bay. Learning activities will be taking place in the school and at the gallery to inspire pupils across the curriculum. The children will be working with a member of the galleries learning team at school to make a collaborative work of pottery that will be exhibited at Turner Contemporary in November.

The children will be visiting the gallery on two separate days. These will be;

**Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> October** – where pupils will spend a whole day at the gallery to explore the exhibition by taking part in a series of different workshops led by the gallery and other cultural organisations including Canterbury Museum, SEAS and the Kent Dance Network.

**Friday 18<sup>th</sup> November** – Pupils will attend a private view of their work in the gallery and take part in a clay workshop.

The project has been funded by the charity Children and the Arts Start Programme. Free rail transport to and from the gallery on both dates has been supplied by Southeastern trains. Children will leave school after morning registration and return by the end of the school day on both days.

If your child receives universal free school meals then they will be provided with a packed lunch for the visit. If they are not registered for a universal free school meal you will need to provide your child with a packed lunch. Please ensure they have a small backpack to carry their lunch in.

Children should wear their school uniform and comfortable shoes. They will also need a waterproof coat in case of rain.

As with all our trips we will not be able to go ahead without your support. Please sign and return the consent form below and indicate if you or a family member will be able to help us on this trip.
