

We would like to inform you of some of the ways that we are marking your children's books, so that when you see certain colours on their work you will know what they mean.

A green pen means 'Green for Growth'. This indicates when your child has achieved something in their writing.

A pink pen means 'Pink to Think'. This indicates where something has to be corrected to improve their writing.

We use green and pink symbols to help the children to understand what they need to do.

Here is an example. In this case the Pink to Think 'CL' symbol means Capital Letter. The child would then correct the letter, making the 'i' a capital.
