Year 1 Trip to Wingham Wildlife Park

Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 1 are visiting Wingham Wildlife Park on Friday 8th June 2018. This will be our Stunning Starter, where children will be immersed into the Paws, Claws and Scales Connector. Much of the children's work for Term 6 will stem from this trip and the impact this will have on their learning will be huge!

We have planned to leave school by coach at 9.45am promptly and return to school for 3.00pm. The children, who usually receive a Universal Infant Free School Dinner, will be provided with a school packed lunch on the day of the trip. If you normally provide a packed lunch for your child, please do so for the trip.

The trip will involve a fair amount of walking and the weather may be unpredictable, so we recommend that all children are equipped with a lightweight waterproof jacket, a 2 strapped backpack, a water bottle and sun cream. If your child suffers from travel sickness, please ensure they take any medication prior to coming into school. Children will be expected to wear full school uniform but may wear alternative sensible shoes for the trip.

Due to the kind donations that families have made throughout this school year and by the PTA, we have managed to cut the costs considerably. We would appreciate a donation of **£11.00** per child. If you are having financial difficulties, or if you would prefer to pay the amount in instalments, please speak to your child's class teacher or the school's FLO. This will be in complete confidence.

Sadly, if we cannot raise the total of **£11.00** per child or if we do not have enough offers of helpers, we will not be able to go on this trip.

As with all our trips we need support as to take the children off site. A ratio of one adult to six children is the legal requirement. Please sign and return the consent form below and indicate if you or a family member will be able to help us on this trip.

On Wednesday 6th June at 2.30 there will be a meeting to discuss the trip and plans for the day.
