Thank you to all our parents and carers who came into our Reading Mornings and helped with our Year 2 trip to church. It was lovely to see so many of you.

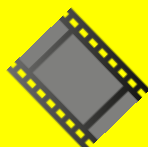
Thank you to the PTA for agreeing to finance our Early Excellence resources.

Lunchtime Award

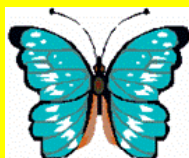
