Ross writes weird and wonderful award-winning books for children, published by Faber & Faber. His debut **Alex, The Dog & The Unopenable Door** (2013) was nominated for the Costa Children's Book of the Year, and selected as one of The Sunday Times "Top 100 Modern Children's Classics".

His follow-up **The Tornado Chasers** (2014) was chosen for the nationwide Booktrust BookBuzz scheme, and his third book **Perijee And Me** (2016) was nominated for the CILIP Carnegie Award and won the Weald Book Award. His most recent book is **Max And The Millions** (2018), which was published on World Book Day.

He will be selling discount signed copies of the book (£5.50) so if children would like to buy a copy could they bring the money to their class teacher. We will keep extra copies in the school to purchase for a short period.
