TOP TIPS FOR PARKING SMART

- We recommend you park safely, legally and considerately
- Consider parking further away from the school and walking the last 5 or 10 minutes
- Never park on the yellow zig zag or double yellow lines
- Try and park at least 10m from a road junction
- Never park on or mount pavements which prevents people walking safely on the pavements
- Don't park in front of residential driveways
- Always respect local residents
- Do not park over bus stops
- Take care when reversing in and out of parking spaces, look and be aware of children crossing
- Avoid parking in awkward spaces where visibility is an issue
- Avoid rushing, it's hard when you are late on the school run and you have a 101 things to do but your children and of others are far more important than those few minutes that you may save rushing and driving too fast.
