Attendance

The information outlined below highlights the amount of time that 90% attendance equates to. Please be mindful that odd days here and there add up to a significant time period where children are missing quality learning time.

90% attendance means that your child is absent for the equivalent of one half-day per week.

In Year 1 90% attendance rate means that your child has missed the equivalent or **four whole weeks** of lessons in the school year.

If your child continues to attend for 90% of the time that they are at primary school, they will miss a total of **23 weeks** which is equivalent to over half a school year.
