Admissions Year 3 – Herne Bay Junior School

Applications for transfer to primary school for September 2019 open on Monday 5 November 2018 and close at midnight on Tuesday 15 January 2019.

You can apply for up to 3 schools, putting them in order of preference. It's in your best interests to list 3 schools. Naming only one school does not guarantee your child a place at that school or give your child priority for a place over another child, neither does naming a school more than once.

To apply to a school outside of Kent, name the school in your application along with your other preferences. Your application details will be passed on to the relevant local authority for processing.
