



Subject Knowledge Organiser - Which animal could I be?

This term our focus will be on Science and we will be learning all about the different animal groups.

Throughout term we will look at different groups of animals and whether animals are invertebrates or vertebrates.



Key Vocabulary:

Mammal – A group of warm-blooded animals with hair or fur who feed their baby's milk.



Bird – A group of animals who have feathers and wings and lay eggs.



Fish – A group of animals who lay eggs and have fins and gills.



Reptile – A group of cold-blooded animals with scales.



Amphibian – A group of animals that live in and out of water, have moist skin and lay eggs.



Backbone – Spine.

Skeleton – Bones.

Invertebrate – Animal without a backbone.

Vertebrate – Animal with a backbone.
