- ☺ **We show kindness to everyone; kind hands; kind feet; kind words.**
- ☺ **We play safely. We think about and manage the risks so that we can keep everyone safe.**
- ☺ **We respect and look after our school environment and equipment.**
- ☺ **We share with others.**
- ☺ **We make our own choices about what we play.**
- ☺ **We sort out problems ourselves in a kind, understanding manner before seeking help from an adult if needed.**
- ☺ **We listen to and value the ideas of others.**
- ☺ **We help and support other people if they need us.**
- ☺ **We work as a team and ALL help to tidy up and take responsibility for our play environment.**

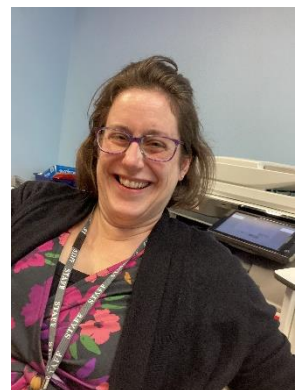
This term, we will be focussing on den making during play time.
